Atlantica is firmly committed to the underlying principles and benefits of maintaining an Environmental Stewardship Management System, or ES-MS, that is fully compatible with the current requirements of ISO 14001:2015, meets all applicable regulatory requirements, and is supportive of the local communities in which we operate.

We are committed to seeking measures to reduce our environmental footprint by:

- Utilizing environmentally friendly products wherever possible.
- Substituting recycled products at every opportunity.
- Reducing consumption of resources and the generation of waste.
- Incorporating waste and spill containment systems into our facilities.
- Reporting and tracking waste products and emissions.
- Setting and tracking environmental preservation targets.

We are committed to the prevention of pollution and maintain a "no spills" philosophy at all times. Team Members are required to immediately report any environmental spills should they occur, are empowered to suspend an operation that could potentially harm the environment, and will be supported for their efforts afterwards.

The ES-MS will undergo continued development through team-led committees, periodic audits to measure its effectiveness, management reviews to ensure alignment of operations with environmental goals, and evaluation of feedback from multiple sources to ensure continual improvement of our environmental performance.


